DON'T delay your opening lead by writing in your personal scorecard; make your lead, and then write.



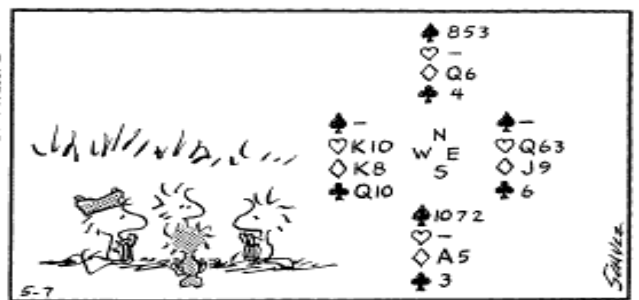
Try to avoid wearing strong fragrances in the playing venue. Perfume, cologne, and other robust scents can become overpowering in a closed-in area.
