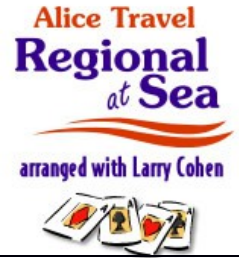

Q. Which holding is more likely to win two tricks: AJ10 or AQ2?

A. AJ10- The simple finesse is only 50%, but if you lead towards the AJ10 twice you will take two tricks if either the King or Queen or both are onside- 75%. Take advantage of knowing your odds!

Matchpoint Strategy

We made our contract... why didn't we do better?

Remember in matchpoints, your score doesn't matter. It's how you do relative to everyone else. If you open 1NT with a balanced 15, everyone else probably did too! If everyone else made 8 tricks, making only 7 is a bad score. You have to fight for every trick.
