### Team Strategy

In Imp scoring (what we use in teams) your TOTAL score matters. If you get 400 points for making 3NT and your teammates lose 150 for 1NT making that 250 points translates to winning 6imps. If you are vulnerable the difference of 450 (600-150) is 10imps! Be aggressive in bidding vulnerable games.

In matchpoints, you have to fight for every trick, but atimps you want to guarantee your contract as declarer or attempt to defeat it as a defender.
