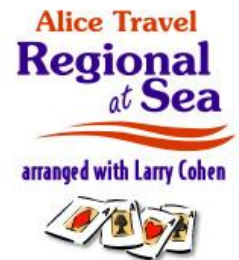




ACBL REGIONAL AT SEA WITH ROBERT TODD

Todd's Tips

Words of wisdom from Robert's lectures

Low-level doubles are primarily takeout. What should you do with a hand that wants to make a penalty double? If, say, partner opens 1♣ and the opponent interferes 2♥ and you hold AQ1082 of hearts, what should you do? The answer: a "trap pass". Since partner is known to have only one or two hearts, partner is likely to reopen with a takeout double. You will convert this to penalty by passing, snaring your opponents in your trap.

ABOUT KNOCKOUTS

If you haven't played in a knockout team before, give it a try tonight. Team games are fun, and the strategy is very different from duplicate. In team games, your total points matter much more than overtricks or undertricks so as a declarer you will try to ensure your contract and as a defender, you can make riskier plays that give your side a chance to defeat a contract.

Playing in team events means that you will have to keep your own score. If you don't know the score for a result, you can always look on the back of the bidding card as it will show all the scores for that contract making. Don't be afraid to ask a director or one of our staff for help if you need it!
