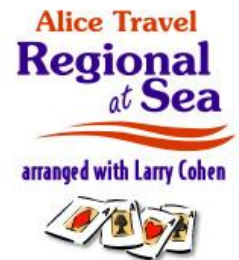




ACBL REGIONAL AT SEA WITH ROBERT TODD

Pace of play

You don't have to be the speediest player if you use these steps to keep the game moving

- Always put down dummy before entering scores in your private scorer or the bridgemate
- Score in the bridgemate before your private score to allow your opponents to move for the next round
- If the round is called and you are still playing a board, make sure to pass your completed boards to the next table
- Save discussions for after the game or between rounds, always move for the next table if the round has been called

Todd's Tips

Words of wisdom from Robert's lectures

Knowing what bids are forcing and what bids aren't is a topic that's more important to discuss with partner than what esoteric conventions you want to add. Discuss with partner: What is forcing after 1♠--dbl--? Is a reverse by responder forcing to game or just one round? Knowing how partner thinks about forcing bids will allow you to be comfortable making a bid that you might otherwise worry would be passed out.
