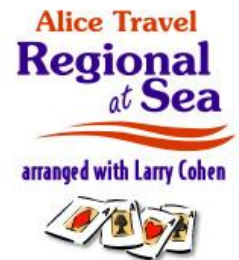




ACBL REGIONAL AT SEA WITH ROBERT TODD

Todd's Tips

Words of wisdom from Robert's lectures

Try to develop a consistent overcall style. Partner should be able to know what to expect in a particular situation. In general, Robert recommends overcalling aggressively on the 1-level. This avoids the headache of needing to balance later.

The 2-level is a different story. Robert says a two-level overcall should be expected to have a six-card suit and an opening hand. Just because that's expected doesn't mean you must hold a 6-card suit, but KQJ95 looks like 6 whereas K7654 doesn't.

If you want to make a bid, but don't have a good enough suit to bid on the 2-level, you may consider making an offshape takeout double. Just try to be sure that you are reasonably comfortable passing whatever partner bids.
