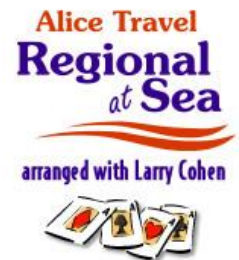

Todd's Tips

Words of wisdom from Robert's lectures

Defending requires firm concentration, but it also requires putting yourself in declarer's shoes. What will declarer try to do? If declarer isn't doing what you expect, try to think of why. For instance, if KQJ109 is in dummy in a notrump contract, and declarer doesn't start by playing that suit, try to think why: usually it's because declarer has the ace and that suit is already set up.

You can even think of how the play will go before you make the opening lead. Listen to the auction to determine whether you should make an active lead (like leading away from the K) or passive lead (like three small). If dummy has a long suit that you hold Qxx in, it's time to get aggressive, because that suit can be easily established. Conversely, if the opponents have slowly stumbled into game after many invitations, then you should be passive and make declarer work for all of her tricks .
