Lessons Learned

Useful tips picked up from Barbara Seagram's lectures

On opening lead, when you are leading partner's suit and have three or four small cards, what should you lead?

Normally, when leading from 3 small e.g. 952, we lead the 9 i.e. Top of Nothing versus K742 where we lead the 2...Bottom Of Something . Use my acronym B.O.S.T.O.N. If we have raised partner with 3 small, we lead the top of nothing. Since you raised, partner will know you do not have a doubleton. BUT if you have NOT raised, lead small from 952. This way she knows you do not have a doubleton as with 92, you would always lead the top of a doubleton.
