## **TODD'S TIPS**

### **Words of wisdom from Robert Todd**

Overcalls on the 1-level can be made for all sorts of reasons; good hands, bad hands, in-between hands. Vulnerability and seat will dictate your actions. On the 2-level, you should have both an opening-ish hand and either a six-card suit or a suit that you could imagine as six-cards.

What is a suit that you could imagine as six-cards? KQ1098 or AQJ97 both look like six cards or could play opposite a singleton.

Don't overcall with a bad suit and only 9 or 10 points or your partner might believe you and raise you to the three-level. You can get altitude sickness at that height!
