North deals, NS vul, IMPs

You are south and you hold:

♦ K94
♣ AJ73

3NT	61%	5%
3S	2%	5%
4C	10%	62%

3S "3NT might be the knee-jerk (majority) instinct, but it is a bad call. The heart suit is wide-open. You might have a laydown game/slam in a minor when 3NT goes down (just picture partner with a small singleton or a void in hearts)." **-Larry Cohen**

4D "16 points with distribution and partner opened. That's 29 points enough for game in a minor. i wouldn't bid no trump without a stopper in hearts." -Name Unavailable

4C "With 15 pts opposite an opening bid you should be looking for slam. It obvious North has nothing in hearts, so in NT you have 5 losers off the top if they lead them. Your best bet is a 4-4 fit in clubs." -Name Unavailable
