1) North Deals, none vul.

- 1) Conservative based on opening light style and very quacky hand.
- 2) Promises 3 hearts and 0-1 diamond; denies a minimum opening bid.

Scores: 4♥ 11; 2♥ 9; 3♥ 7; 3♣ 5; 1NT 3; 2NT 1

2) East Deals, N-S vul.

- 1) Larry prefers (if possible) a 2/1 GF auction to using inverted minors.
- 2) Promises 4 spades, denies 4 hearts, denies 5+ diamonds, so guarantees exactly 4 diamonds.
- 3) Kickback (keycard ask with diamonds trump).
- 4) 1 (or 4) keycards.
- 5) Shows interest in 7♦ (or rarely, 6NT) asking about kings (usually shows all the keycards and ♦ Q).
- 6) Accepting the invitation based on an ideal club holding and a maximum for a balanced hand not strong enough for a 14-16 1NT opening.
- 7) Much happier to play the grand slam in our agreed suit.

Scores: 7 ◆ 12; 6NT 8; 6 ◆ 3; 7NT
